

Piancavallo Ski rules and fines in effect until end of season

The 2013 winter season skiing rules and guidelines are now in effect in Piancavallo. Individuals who do not abide by the ordinance could be fined up to 300 euro and have their ski pass revoked. The following rules will be in effect until the end of the winter season:

SPEED: Skiers should maintain a safe speed when traveling down slopes. When approaching corners, building, fog, beginners, bottlenecks, or any other low visibility areas, skiers should slow down to ensure the safety of all patrons. Fine: 50-250 euros.

PRIORITY: Skiers must do everything within their power to prevent collisions with other skiers. Fine: 50-250 euros.

OVERTAKING: Skiers must ensure that the space needed to overtake someone is adequate and the view is clear. Fine: 50-250 euros.

CROSSING: When crossing slopes, skiers coming from the right of the trail or who have given the appropriate hand signal have priority. Fine: 50-250 euros.

RESTING: Skiers needing to rest must stay on the slope's border. Fine: 50-250 euros.

PASSAGE AND RECLIMBING: It is forbidden to walk through the ski slopes, except for emergency cases. Skiers may walk on the ski slope's border. Fine: 100-150 euros.

OFF-SLOPE SKIING: The manager of the ski slope is not responsible for any accident that may happen off -slope, and every off-slope skier must have a personal safety system in case of avalanche, and those found without one will be fined. Fine: 150-250 euros

MANDATORY HELMET: Children under 14 are required to wear an approved helmet. In the areas dedicated to snowboarding and the Funpark in the Caprioli's area, Adults are also required to wear a helmet. Fine: 100-200 euros.

SLEDS, AND RUBBER BOATS: The use of sleds is only allowed in certain areas, but the use of rubber boars is forbidden. Fine: 30-150 euros.

COMPETITION SLOPES: During a competition, it is forbidden to cross the delimitation line marking the competition area. Fine: 30-150 euros

ALCOHOL USE: Any skier determined to be drunk will, in addition to the 51-309 euros fine, will also have their ski pass revoked by police agents.
