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City tour: Gorizia

As many cities on the border between Countries, Gorizia is a real crossroad of Italian and Slovenian cultures. Despite its small size, it's really rich in Art and History. The heart of the city is its castle, center of a beautiful Hamlet-Museum, All around are Palaces and architectures from Middle Ages to the XIX century, surrounded by the typical vineyard hills landscape and also including Rare Plants gardens and parks. The Multicultural vocation is the distinctive feature of Tarvisio and the Fusine lakes, right on the North-Eastern corner of Friuli. This very ancient mountain settlement is in fact on the border between Italy, Austria and Slovenia, representing the best of the 3 Countries' landscapes, traditions, history, food, hospitality and events! Natisone is an important river crossing the border from Slovenia through Udine and Gorizia territory. The incredible environments around it are called The Valleys of Natisone: river shores, caves and gorges, meadows and forests, crossed by the panoramic roads through the hills, the many votive churches, a Langobards temple, city walls made with the river stones, the antique abandoned hamlets, the Castles.. Villa Manin di Passariano

On the road to Udine, this Villa with its park is one of the largest Venetian villas in Italy, inspired by nothing less than Versailles architecture! The main building, rich in frescoes, sculptures and stuccoes between Baroque and Rococo art, is often hosting exhibitions, while the park is used for concerts, open theater events and Landart.
