European Travel Awareness



Several terrorist incidents involving <u>vehicles</u> and <u>easily obtained weapons</u> have occurred in Europe, including the United Kingdom, Germany, France, Spain, Finland, and Russia.

These incidents have occurred at <u>mass gathering locations</u> – such as large commercial, pedestrian, and tourist areas – to maximize casualties.

These events are stark reminders of terrorists' clear intent to execute attacks in Europe with little to no warning.

INDIVIDUAL PROTECTIVE MEASURES

- Provide travel plans and contact info to your chain of command
- Travel in a small group (avoid separation from the group)
- Identify existing obstacles (barriers, trees, light poles, etc.) and walk on the side that provides protection from a vehicle ramming attack
- Stay current with media coverage to remain aware of rapid changes in the security environment
- Blend in with the local population and do not act in a way to draw attention to yourself
- Avoid demonstrations and exercise caution in the vicinity of a large gathering
- Cooperate with security procedures and inspections
- Know local emergency numbers and potential safe areas
- Be cautious in high risk areas such as hotel lobbies, nightclubs, and other public places (i.e., sporting arenas) and identify exits upon arrival

SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY REPORTING

- Remain aware and alert for anything suspicious or out of place
- Immediately report suspicious activity to local law enforcement officials

IDENTIFICATION

- Carry military ID and dependents' official passport & soggiorno with you at all times
- Carry tourist passport with you outside Italy
- Use state-issued ID or tourist passport during hotel check-in

SOCIAL MEDIA and OPSEC

- Do not post departure and arrival times or locations
- Do not "check-in" or post hotel location or geo-tagged photos until you leave the area
- Be cautious of your conversations in public areas
- Avoid revealing your DOD affiliation
